What do we do when we arrive at nursery?

Arrival routine:

- Parents and carers wait with their child at the nursery entry gate.
- The morning session run from 8.25am until 11.25am, and the afternoon session 12.00pm until 3.00pm. The nursery teacher will greet you at the door.
- The nursery team will invite your child into the nursery classroom.
- The children will find their name labels to self-register.
- Lunch bags will be put on the shelf.
- Children will put their bags and coats on their pegs.
- The teacher will then take the register.
- Children select a child initiated activity inside the classroom.



What do we bring to nursery?

At nursery your child will need:

- A bag every day
- Water bottle every day
- Spare change of clothes, which will be sent home at the end of each half term to be washed
- A suitable coat or jacket, as the children will have access the outdoor area everyday in all weathers.

Please remember to clearly label all your child's belongings.



What do we do at nursery?

A typical day within our nursery class consists of:

- child initiated learning
- adult led phonics – Read, Write Inc., literacy and mathematics
- adult led focus activities
- fruit snack time
- outdoor learning.





Snack and Lunch Time

- The children will have the opportunity to sit down and select their own fruit and water/milk to drink.
- Lunch time is at 11.25am for the children who have a fulltime place. They will eat their lunch in the school dining room where adults will help and support them.
- If your child brings a packed lunch to nursery, please ensure it is clearly labelled and **NUT FREE**, as we are a **NUT FREE SCHOOL** – this also includes Nutella and Peanut Butter!
- We encourage children to bring a healthy packed lunch. Please avoid sweet treats if possible.



What to wear for nursery

Uniform is available to purchase from the school office, however it is not compulsory in nursery. We strongly encourage you to dress your child in comfortable clothes (e.g. tracksuit bottoms, leggings and Velcro trainers) so that they can independently go to the toilet and engage in physical and creative activities.

- Suitable shoes, no flip flops or croc type shoes.
- Waterproof coat and suitable seasonal accessories, such as sun hat or gloves.
- No jewellery, only stud earrings.

The Early Years Curriculum is called 'The Foundation Stage' and is organised into 7 areas of learning.

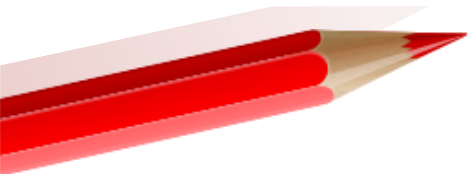

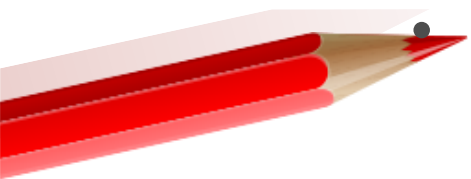




Further information ...
